AWARD DETAILS

- Companies and individuals may nominate themselves or may be nominated by a third party.
- Nominations are scored by the members of the Greater Omaha Excellence Awards Selection Committee, which is comprised of business leaders and past award recipients from the Greater Omaha area. Individual scores are kept confidential.
- All nominated businesses or individuals must be Greater Omaha Chamber members based in the Greater Omaha metropolitan area: Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders and Washington counties in Nebraska and Harrison, Mills and Pottawattamie counties in Iowa.
- Nominations are accepted online from Jan. 5 through Feb. 12, 2016.
 Late nominations will not be considered.
- Final Excellence Award winners will be notified by a member of the Greater Omaha Chamber staff and announced publicly through the news channels chosen by the Chamber and additionally recognized at a private reception.
- Excellence Award winners are invited to a party on May 10, and are encouraged to invite their networks to help celebrate their recognition. The event is open to the public.
